REPORT TO MEMBERS 2008 – 09

STATEMENT TO MEMBERS ISSUED IN CONNECTION WITH THE UNION'S ANNUAL RETURN FOR PERIOD TO 30 SEPTEMBER 2008 AS REQUIRED BY SECTION 32A OF TRADE UNION AND LABOUR RELATIONS (CONSOLIDATION) ACT 1992

Income and Expenditure

The total income of the union for the year ended 30 September 2008 was £4,349,199. This amount included payments of £3,825,125 in respect of membership of the union. The union's total expenditure for the period was £4,182,431. The union does not maintain a political fund.

Salary paid to and other benefits provided to the General Secretary, President and members of the Executive

The Chief Executive Officer was paid a salary of £39,760 in respect of the Society plus National Insurance and Pension contributions of £9,176. Similar amounts are paid in respect of the College of Radiographers. None of the following received a salary or any benefits from the company: Society Council members, the President, Vice President, President Elect or Immediate Past President.

Irregularity statement As required by sub section (6) (a) of the Act

A member who is concerned that some irregularity may be occurring, or have occurred, in the conduct of the financial affairs of the union may take steps with a view to investigating further, obtaining clarification and, if necessary, securing regularisation of that conduct.

The member may raise any such concern with such one or more of the following as it seems appropriate to raise it with: the officials of the union, the trustees of the property of the union, the auditor or auditors of the union, the Certification Officer (who is an independent officer appointed by the Secretary of State) and the police.

Where a member believes that the financial affairs of the union have been or are being conducted in breach of the law or in breach of the rules of the union and contemplates bringing civil proceedings against the union or responsible officials or trustees, he should consider obtaining independent legal advice.

Reporting on Summarised Accounts

The figures on the preceding page have been extracted from the full Society Report and financial statements, which have been audited by Horwath Clark Whitehill LLP, who gave an unqualified audit report on 24 March 2009. The auditors have confirmed to the Council that the summarised financial statements are consistent with the full financial statements for the year ended on 30 September 2008. The Council's Report and financial statements were approved by Council and signed on their behalf on 4 March 2009.

These summarised financial statements may not contain sufficient information to gain a complete understanding of the financial affairs of the union.
