- Support teaching across a range of papers or in clinical settings, to post-graduate level, in the professional area of specialisation. This includes preparation, assessment, teaching and paper administration duties.
- Carry out administration responsibilities.
- Contribute to Department's academic goals by applying and sharing expert knowledge in a professional discipline.

- A degree endorsed in radiation therapy
- A postgraduate qualification or other indication of a high degree of competence in radiation therapy
- A record of service to the radiation therapy profession
- Clinical experience as a radiation therapist

- Must be either registered as a radiation therapist or be eligible to be so registered in New Zealand

- Self-motivated, able to work with minimal supervision or as part of a team

- Current and relevant knowledge of radiation therapy research.
