Role Purpose:

- To carry out a full range of general and specialised radiographic procedures maintained to high technical and patient care standards, and to apply the lowest radiation doses possible consistent with good diagnostic images, and a safe environment.
- To be responsible for the efficient and safe operation of the Imaging Centre.

Core Responsibilities:

- Manage and plan individual investigations required, and follow the instructions of the supervisory radiologist.
- To support the Director and the Team Leaders of the department.
- Produce images to a previously agreed standard, using techniques that produce the lowest radiation dose to the patient and staff.
- Practice good radiation protection and safety, and observe "local rules" and "systems of work" and IR (ME) R guidelines.
- To administer Intravenous cannulation and injection of substances (contrast administration).
- Manage the designated working area and ensure that it is tidy, clean and efficiently run.
- Undertake other non-radiographic duties as necessary.
- Report all equipment malfunctions or faults to the manager or R.P.S. and if necessary undertake any further action to ensure the safe operation of the equipment.
- Participate in and contribute to Quality Assurance tests within the Imaging Centre.
- Participate in and contribute to the constant monitoring and reviewing of radiographic and service standards and HW.
- Maintain a high standard of customer/patient care and ensure as a team member that this is maintained throughout the Imaging Centre and hospital.
- Practise and observe all company, hospital and Imaging Centre policies and procedures. These include Health & Safety, Fire, COSHH and manual handling.
- Report any hazards or incidents and participate in risk assessments.
- Ensure cost effective use of consumables and the need for cost efficiency generally.
- Ensure that his/her knowledge of technical and professional matters is up to date (C.P.D.).
- Participate in the Imaging Centre's on-call/rota system.
- Maintain a high professional conduct and IR (ME) R compliance, and observe strict confidentiality at all times.
- Must be able to use all IT systems including Ultragenda CRIS and PACS.

- To assist with PACS administration as a super user.

In particular to comply with departmental policies relating to Health & Safety, Infection Control and Radiation Safety procedures.
- To actively participate in the promotion of your department and the hospital.
- To participate in mandatory training, personal development and the appraisal system as appropriate.
- To perform any other reasonable duties as requested by your Head of Department.

- Efficient and accurate production of high quality diagnostic images with low radiation dose to the patients and within a safe environment.
- Multi-skills within the Imaging Centre utilizing knowledge and technical abilities.
- Awareness of cost efficiency.
