- To maintain and enhance the knowledge and skills of radiographers in relation to the informatics agenda.
- To influence the national informatics agenda.
- To promote best practise within the field of radiography.
- To engage with and support other relevant professional groups involved in informatics and key stakeholders.
- To develop guidance for publication by The College of Radiographers.
- To facilitate the study of health informatics in continuous professional development and the undergraduate and postgraduate programmes of education.
