SUBJECT: ON-CALL REVIEW

Emergency Motion No. 1

As a result of prior ADC motions, UK Council is committed to a full consultation and ballot of the membership regarding the outcome of the national on-call review. Conference notes recent developments, as reported to UK Council on 3rd March, the NHS Staff Council on 31st March, and as published in SoR News. It is looking increasingly likely that the review outcome will be a framework of principles that will apply across the UK within which local schemes may be determined. In this event, this Conference believes that a ballot is no longer automatically required.

This Conference calls on UK Council to:

- Consult with the membership on the proposed revised NHS Staff Council On-Call arrangements once they become available. This should be done by direct contact with the membership, and gaining opinions from reps meetings and RCs and NCs.
- From the evidence collected, determine and publish the detailed results of the consultation.
- From the result of the consultation, determine and publish with reasons whether a full ballot of the membership is required.
