Richard Evans' first job on leaving school was as a hospital porter at University College Hospital in London, where he worked in the x-ray department. Inspired by the radiographers there, he went on to train as a diagnostic radiographer at the Middlesex Hospital and qualified with the Diploma of the College of Radiographers in 1982. Richard worked in London and specialised in neurological imaging before moving to Salisbury District Hospital where he set up the first CT scanning and subsequently MRI scanning services. He went on to be appointed as General Manager for the Radiology Directorate at Poole Hospital.

Richard has been Chief Executive Officer of the Society and the College of Radiographers since 2004.

He was awarded the OBE in 2016 for services to radiography.
