The Medical Imaging Department has a small team of 10 staff, most full time but some part time, comprising full time equivalents of 1½ Ultrasonographers, 5 Radiographers, 1 Assistant Practitioner and 1 PACS/RIS/Admin Officer.

Our equipment includes a new general DR room, CR room with under couch fluoroscopy, a new DR mobile, CR mobile, a new DR OPT/CEPH unit, 64 slice CT scanner and ultrasound. We have a local PACS and are fully integrated with the Scottish national PACS system.

The department is within the Gilbert Bain Hospital, Lerwick, an island general/acute hospital serving Shetlands 22,000 residents plus the offshore oil industry and maritime population. The hospital provides acute/elective general surgical and general medical inpatient and outpatient services in addition to consultant led A&E. More specialist services are provided by visiting consultants and tele-medicine services. There is no resident Radiologist but we have reporting ultrasonographers and a reporting radiographer. We work closely with local clinicians providing the usual in/out patient, GP and acute 24-hour service cover with Radiologist support provided remotely. An on call commitment is expected for which an allowance is payable.
