## **Senior MRI Research Radiographer**

We are seeking an enthusiastic Radiographer to join our dynamic team at Mansfield Centre for Innovation at Imperial College (Hammersmith Campus). The Mansfield Centre has an international reputation for imaging research and brings together Scientists and Clinicians working on cardiovascular, neurological and metabolic projects. The Unit is equipped with 2 clinical Siemens MR scanners - a 3T Prisma system for advanced neuro applications and multi-nuclear spectroscopy, and a 1.5T Aera system for cardiovascular, foetal and body imaging.

You will be performing magnetic resonance imaging on subjects taking part in research studies and will be required to assist in the day-to-day organisation and management of MRI projects.

The integrity of our research data underpins the work we do and so it is essential that you are well-organised and have attention to detail. The successful applicant should enjoy setting goals, working intensively on a project and will be encouraged to partake in the post-processing and analysis of the MR data. This work requires flexibility and an eagerness to learn new techniques, so you will need to be adaptable and be committed to continuous professional development. It is also essential that the postholder is educated to a BSc or Diploma level in Diagnostic Radiography or equivalent, with a registration with the Health and Care Profession Council.

The postholder will be an experienced Radiographer providing the highest standards of patient care. Although a background in research MRI would be beneficial it is not essential as this role would provide on-the-job training in research skills, cardiac and advanced neuro imaging techniques delivered by our experienced team of Radiographers, Physicists and Scientists. We provide excellent training and development for all levels of experience.

This is a 3-year fixed term post. Working hours will be not normally less than 35 hours per week. Applications for less than full time will be considered.
