2. Project Title	Understanding patient experience of premalignant pancreatic cystic lesion surveillance to inform the development of an intervention to improve current care.

6. Summary of objectives	Explore the patient experiences of imaging surveillance for premalignant pancreatic disease.
7. Summary of work and findings to date	<p>Narrative literature review: Explore patient experiences of surveillance for premalignant & low risk cancer and identify the factors that affect patient experience. Findings: adequate patient support, information and communication reduces patient's anxiety and in turn helps patients accept the surveillance management, reducing stress and burden of surveillance. Patients require additional support and information from health care professionals and methods to combat their test induced fears during surveillance.</p> <p>4 interviews completed, transcribed and analysed. Ongoing recruitment across 2 NHS sites.</p>
8. Summary of work ongoing	Awaiting R&D to resume recruitment for remaining interviews (4 of 30 interviews complete to date).
9. Summary of future plans – please include an estimate timeline for work progression	Complete recruitment and interviews, this time period has been extended (with ethical and R&D approval) from an 18 month period to a 30 month period to allow for the interruption of study activity during COVID-19.
